Responsibilities

1. Teach at least twelve (12) hours a semester at the undergraduate level;
2. Participate in student advisement;
3. Serve on college committees;
4. Participate in scholarly and/or professional activities;
5. Recruit and mentor adjunct faculty within the discipline;
6. Recruit and effectively mentor students to fulfill the goal of effective Biblical Communication as it intersects with both adult and youth culture;
7. Collaborate in the design and development of the next significant model for effective Biblical Communication;
8. Serve the institution, local church, and/or surrounding community as requested by the Administration.

General Qualifications Required

- Possess a mature and growing Christian character;
- Actively participate in the life of a local church;
- Promote a Christ-Centered, Biblically-based worldview;
- Subscribe to the principles of New Testament Christianity as demonstrated by the Restoration Movement and assent to the College's "Statement of Faith;"
- Demonstrate a commitment to teaching;
- Demonstrate a commitment to the application of instructional technology;
- Instruct in a manner that reveals how a Christian worldview intersects with and influences non-Christian culture.

Specific Qualifications Desired

- Demonstrated ability to communicate to a diverse audience (e.g., racially, generationally, size of audience, etc.);
- Demonstrated success in administering programs for the Church;
- Demonstrated competency in effective ministry to the current youth culture;
- Demonstrated capacity to revise and champion a program that will produce the next generation of effective Biblical communicators.
