



Student Housing Information

Our campus features suite style housing. Each suite will have two bedrooms (11x11), one living room (11x16), two study areas, and two bathrooms. Each suite is approximately 800 square feet.

Each bedroom is equipped with the following furniture:

- 3 - Twin size beds with 30"x80" mattress
- 3 - Bed shelf (33"w x 10 ¾" d)
- 1 - five drawer chest
- 2 - two drawer under bed chests

Each living room is equipped with the following furniture:

- 1 - round high top table
- 4 - fiji barstools
- 1 - one drawer end table
- 1 - two drawer coffee table
- 1 - entertainment center (42"w x 22"d x 31"h)
- 1 - sofa
- 1 - loveseat

Each study room has a built in desk and bookshelves with three two-position upholstered chairs.

Each bathroom has a stand-up shower and toilet, with a sink, mirror, and cabinet on wall outside the bathroom.

Students will need to bring their own bedding, towels and personal items. They can also bring their own computers, electronic equipment, dorm size refrigerator, and throw rugs (the floors are tile). Each suite will have its own phone line, but the phone will not be provided.

Students will not be allowed to bring in additional furniture or microwaves. Students will also not be allowed to nail items onto the walls. Any hanging items must be secured with material provided by the college (such material will be available for purchase during orientation weekend and throughout the semester.)

Storage rooms will not be available. Please bring only what you can fit into your room.

The NCC meal plan will include breakfast and lunch Monday through Friday, supper Monday through Thursday, and a Saturday brunch. All meals will have full course options. Snack rooms with a sink, cabinets, countertop, and microwaves will be available for students to use. Food preparation will not be allowed in the rooms.

Roommate and suitemate assignments will be made only after the \$200 dorm deposit has been paid.
