

Policy Regarding Transfer of College Credit

Nebraska Christian College requires that a student complete a minimum of 32 credit hours of resident study for any degree. Students wishing to transfer to NCC must submit complete and official transcripts of credit from each institution they have attended. The Academic Office evaluates transcripts and grants credit for courses on a case-by-case basis. The amount of credit received from another institution may vary with the courses required in the degree program selected by the student. Consideration is given to the nature of the course, course content, and the level of difficulty in determining the appropriate receipt of transfer credit. To be eligible for the course to transfer, the student must have achieved at least a grade of "C" (2.0) in the class.

Requests for transfer of credit received from non-accredited institutions are evaluated on a) the merits of the institution attended, b) validation by examination, and/or c) a student's level of satisfactory progress during a minimum of one semester of enrollment at NCC.
